

## JCS Data Warehouse Changes for February 7, 2005

DWS has made some changes to the Job Center Systems Data Warehouse effective February 7 relating to the information coming from ASSET. Here's a summary of what has changed:

1. **New Contract ID/Old Contract ID:** In December 2004 ASSET was modified to add a new Contract ID field on each of the services reported in ASSET. The field is now filled from a standardized list that pops up. The old Contract ID field, which was a free-format text field, was made view only.

With the load of data this weekend, all of the corporate reports using Contract ID as one of its elements now point to the new Contract ID field data instead of the information that was in the old Contract ID field.

NOTE: The warehouse now carries data on both the New Contract ID and Old Contract ID, but uses only the New Contract ID in corporate reports.

2. **Skill Attainment Goals for WIA Title 1 Youth:** The warehouse has a new Goals Universe added. Up to this point, Goals and Services were both found in the Services Universe but this caused some problems on some reports. With this enhancement, we have created universes that automatically filter to select only Goals or only Services, depending on the universe chosen. With this change, we also added some additional fields for Youth Goals, including the Goal Text, Performance-Related Goal (Yes or No) and the Planned Date of Attainment. With this new universe, we should be able to create new Youth reports to help you better manage Skill Attainment Goals.
3. **Unemployment Insurance Demonstration Project (Oshkosh/Milwaukee):** Information regarding the UI Demo individuals referred for the WPRS project has been added to the warehouse so we can track services under this project.
4. **Dislocated Worker Employer/SRR & NEG Qualifying Employer:** These two new data fields were added to the warehouse for the first time this month. Both are for the WIA Title 1 Dislocated Worker Program and relate to the employer of dislocation. These new fields may be added to existing reports where appropriate. New reports also are possible.
5. **Exit Source:** We added the source of exit so we will be able to create reports to distinguish individuals who were exited by worker action versus individuals who were soft exited by the ASSET batch process.
6. **Follow-up Status Information:** We added Employment Status and Earnings Amount for each quarter after exit. New reports will be developed in the future that present this data for program managers.
7. **Participation Status:** In the past, the warehouse had reports on registered individuals who were identified as being "Not Enrolled" versus "Enrolled". The definition of what it meant to be enrolled varied by program (or program area) and the reports were often not incorrect because of changing definitions. Beginning with the load of information this past weekend, the warehouse changed significantly. There are now 3 levels of participation status for each program:

**Registered:** A person who has a program registration/program area registration completed but has not had any services reported under that program/program area.

**Pre-Enrolled:** A person is registered for a program/program area, and has had some services reported under that program, but these services do not meet the criteria of 'enrolling' the person in the program. This means the person who is at the Pre-enrolled Level is not counted in Performance Measures.

**Enrolled:** A person who is program-registered and has had services reported under that program or program area, but has had at least one service that is defined as enrolling that person in the program/program area. This means that the person is now counted in Performance Measures.

Use this table as a reference to for the types of services qualifying under each of the participation statuses:
