

## Changes to the Data Warehouse – January 24, 2005

Effective Monday, January 24, 2004, we reorganized the Data Warehouse Corporate Document listing all reports that are available in this data mart. Some reports that once were on this listing have been deleted because they have been replaced by the same single report using the Program Year as a prompt.

We introduced the new PY dimension to the Job Center Systems Data Warehouse last December. The new Program Year option allowed reports that formerly had a version for each Program Year now be listed once, and Program Year (PY) became a prompt parameter. We placed reports that we created using the Program Year prompt in a special listing in the Data Warehouse called JCS Variable. Many of you have already been using this group of reports by requesting the listing for JCS Variable instead of JCS. The merging of the JCS and JCS Variable reports listing into the single JCS listing this past weekend eliminates the need to look in two places for the report you need.

Additionally, we expanded the way in which we look at individuals in reports. The terminology below will help you understand the meaning behind some of the reports.

Active Individuals – Active Individuals reports include registrants who were carried in as 'open' as well as newly registered individuals who 'opened' during the period specified. The person may or may not have been exited, but was active for at least one day in the period specified.

BOM - Coming to the Warehouse in February 2005 is a new dimension – BOM, which stands for Beginning of the Month. BOM reports show individuals who meet the criteria of the report on the first day of the month.

EOM – EOM stands for End Of Month, and includes individuals who meet the criteria of the report as of the last day of a report month.

Program Year – A program year (PY) is the designation for the period of time from July 1 of one year through June 30 of the following year. For example, PY 04 is July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. As a note, you may find CY (calendar year, January 1 – December 31) or FFY (Federal Fiscal Year, October 1 – September 30) shown as the time period in some warehouse reports.
