## **WJOS Business Login Page**

Effective today the [WJOS Employer Login page](#) has been revised.

The new page promotes the JobNet brand as JobNet/Business, taking advantage of JobNet awareness for system uses on both sides of the labor exchange.

Current users will access the system by using the [Employer Login](#) button.

Employer conversion of usernames and passwords has ended. New customers, and any current user that did not convert his/her Username and Password prior to today, will use the [New Account](#) button.

Self-training materials for registering and using the job order system have been revised to reflect the new screen. Links from Department web pages have been updated to direct users to the new page.

Please update any on local web sites or references in local marketing materials to reflect the new page.

There are two additional pieces of information that are important for Job Center staff to know:

- The "Forgot OLD Username/Password" function has been removed from the WJOS menu tree. This was a temporary function, available to staff during the employer username/password conversion process (January 26-June 28).
- The JobNet Employer Group Presentation PowerPoint has been updated for staff to use when speaking to or training employers. Narration is provided for you to use when presenting the PowerPoint. To view the narration and print it, open the PowerPoint, go to View, then Notes Page and print the presentation. The narration will be on the individual pages. This PowerPoint is not a link from the new JobNet Employer Login page, as it is intended for staff use only.
