The "ABC's of LMI" is an introduction to Labor Market Information (LMI) and how it can be incorporated into the development of employment plans. Participants will learn Labor Market Information terms, how to analyze information to identify wages paid for an occupation, skills required for an occupation, the employers that hire a particular occupation. The instructor will be Heather Thompson, Research Analyst, Labor Market Information Section.

"Using LMI Electronic Tools" offers a hands-on opportunity to learn how to access and utilize electronic LMI (Labor Market Information) tools that include O\*Net, WISCareers and the newly developed WorkNet. Participants will learn which tool will work best for them when developing an individual work plan. The instructors will be Roger Gantzarow, Director of Counseling and Testing, and Philip Anderson, Employer Services, Employment Connections Section.

Each course is a half-day session. You may register for one or both sessions on DWD Campus.
