## **System Changes Implemented 1/19/2006**

### **Staff version of JobNet Business**

- The Site Record was not allowing staff to navigate to Application Instruction tab when site had no company description and it was brought down from the profile. This has been corrected.
- "Job Order Counts and Analysis" Report. The report contained an issue counting records on the first date and last day of the period being measured and was showing counts that did not match when you looked at the same month in the different time periods (example the 6, 9, 12 month reports each had different counts for July.) This has been corrected.
- Added numbers back to JobNet Occupational Code dropdown box.

### **Employer version of JobNet Business**

- Added a new menu selection "Enter a New Job Order" that will give employers another, more immediately viewable, path to enter a new job order.
- Added red text to the site list page that indicates "**Please select a site to continue.**"

### **Staff and Employer Versions of JobNet Business**

- Job order issue with clicking buttons more than once. Now when a button is clicked the system disables all other buttons until the action has finished. This also prevents the employer from saving an order complete and then hitting the "back" button and making more changes.
- Problem with application instructions and benefits box being blanked out on copied orders. Now if there are no application instructions or benefits on the site record a copied order will retain the application instructions and benefits from the order being copied.

- Code was added to remove javascript from job order preview emails to alleviate the problem of spam blockers blocking some emailed job order previews.

If staff get returned preview emails they should continue to forward them to [DWSJOBNETHELP@dwd.state.wi.us](mailto:DWSJOBNETHELP@dwd.state.wi.us) to help us determine what is stopping them from getting through.

- Mandatory Statement for temp agencies was not showing up to JobNet users when checked. This has been corrected.
