## **America's Job Bank Phase-out**

The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) is sending this notification to all Job Center staff in order to inform you of the phase out of America's Job Bank, also known as AJB.

As many of you are aware, AJB is being phased out of operation. The date for final phase out is June 30, 2007. This includes the phase out of all its services, including job orders and resume listings. By July 1, 2007, employers and job seekers will no longer be able to access AJB to find resume or job listings.

Specifically, what will occur after June 30, 2007?

- Job orders that were entered by employers on AJB as a self service will no longer be available to job seekers.
- Resumes that were entered by job seekers on AJB as a self service will no longer be available to employers.
- Job orders posted on JobNet that were sent to AJB on a nightly batch process by Wisconsin Job Service will no longer be available to job seekers. These job orders will continue to be posted to JobNet.
- The Career OneStop, Career InfoNet, and the Service Locator will remain available.

On July 1, 2007, AJB will no longer be available and in its place will be a list of other similar websites that customers can access to obtain similar services. Please begin to notify Job Center customers of this planned phase-out of AJB. Attached to this notification you will find a list of [frequently asked questions](#) that has been provided by AJB's transition team. This resource will assist you when discussing the pending phase out with all customers who use AJB resources.

A replacement system, called JobCentral, will be in place on July 1, 2007. Starting July 1, 2007, the services we currently receive from AJB will be provided by JobCentral located at <http://www.JobCentral.com/>.

The phase out of AJB presents an opportunity for Job Center staff to connect with customers and provide information, assistance, and offer services.
