

Veterans Questions Added to "Update My JobNet Registration"

This morning the Veterans questions were added to JobNet in the "Update My JobNet Registration" function. This change was originally suggested by Vets staff. It allows job seekers to update their own veteran's status using JobNet 3.0's update path. The job seeker who is also a veteran receives "veteran's preference" for job orders, plus the veteran will appear at the top of the list on the JobSeeker/Job Order-O*Net Match report. In ASSET, the customer's veteran status is updated (the base customer record is shared by JobNet and ASSET).

The following questions were added. The responses from the customer will determine which questions the customer must answer.

If the above question is answered "yes", the customer goes to:

The customer automatically goes to:

Veteran Status: Use 'Yes' or 'No', and 'Back' buttons to move from page to page.

Have you been awarded an Armed Forces Campaign Badge or Expeditionary Medal?

The customer automatically goes to:

Veteran Status: Use 'Yes' or 'No', and 'Back' buttons to move from page to page.

Are you entitled to or receiving compensation for a service connected disability from the Veterans Administration or from the military?

If the above question is answered "yes", the customer goes to:

Veteran Status: Use 'Yes' or 'No', and 'Back' buttons to move from page to page.

Is your service connected disability rating 30% or more?

If the above question is answered "yes", the customer goes to:

Veteran Status: Use 'Yes' or 'No', and 'Back' buttons to move from page to page.

Is the disability an impairment to work?

Either answer directs the customer to the disclosure question.
