

## Changes Made in JobNet Business & Job Center of Wisconsin

Over the weekend several changes were made in JobNet Business-Staff and with the registration process in JobNet Business-Employer. Some changes were also made in Job Center of Wisconsin.

### JobNet Business-Staff

1. The following items have been removed from the menu tree or job order for staff with employer-only access:
  - Event History button on the job order
  - Job order section on the Manage Employer Updates screen
  - Release Veterans Hold
  - Incomplete Orders
  - System Reports: All Job Orders, Job Orders by Last Contact, Job Orders Removed from JobNet, Reopened Job Orders, and Job Orders to Close

2. The problem with the way the information on the tabs of the employer record was displayed has been fixed.
3. The Pending Orders list now automatically sorts from oldest to newest.
4. The Request for Assistance list now automatically sorts from oldest to newest. There is also a Pending option so staff can easily see which items they have started, but not completed. The Pending list is available by staff person or by all staff persons.

### **JobNet Business - Employer**
