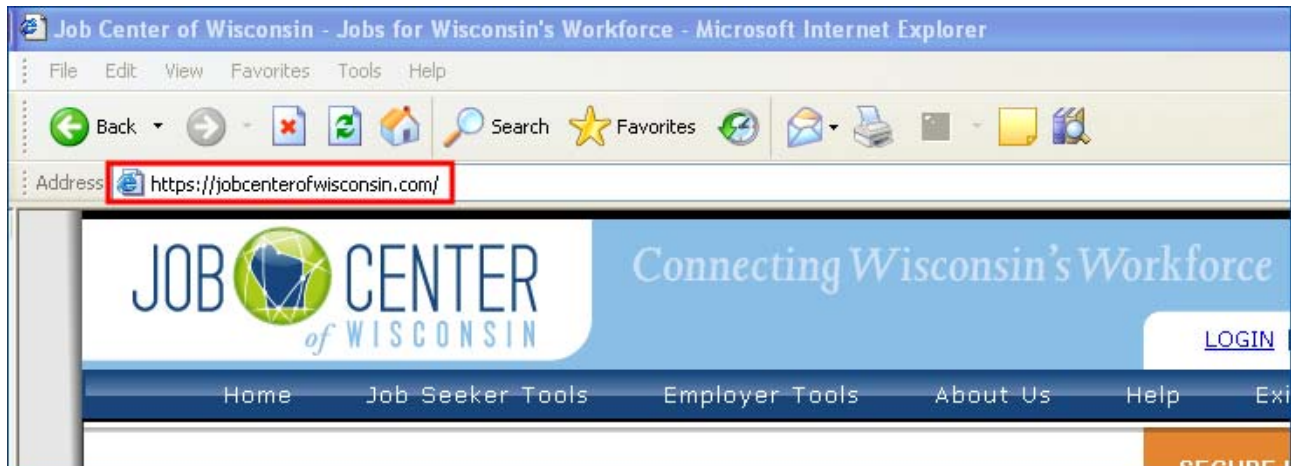

Use Caution When Job Seekers Use Staff PCs to Access JobCenterOfWisconsin.com

When allowing job seekers to use your computer to access JobCenterofWisconsin.com, please make sure that the job seeker is accessing the production ('real') environment, not the Education or User Acceptance environments.

Recently there have been instances of job seekers using a staff member's computer to access JobCenterofWisconsin.com - or so they thought. In actuality, the job seeker was registering and creating a resume in the Education or User Acceptance environment. These situations were discovered when staff couldn't locate the job seekers in ASSET, and the job seekers couldn't access their resumes in the 'real' JobCenterofWisconsin.com.

Whenever you, a job seeker, or an employer are accessing JobCenterofWisconsin.com, check the Address line of the browser to make sure that the production address is shown (see below). The production address is <https://jobcenterofwisconsin.com>.



Staff can and should access the Education environment to try things out, explore, practice, etc. **Do not allow job seekers or employers to use the Education environment!**

Staff should not access the User Acceptance environment unless you have been specifically asked to do so. Job seekers and employers should never be accessing the User Acceptance environment.
